

## LYNX Settings – API Integration

These settings can be found in the "API Integration" area of LYNX's **Configuration - Settings** page.


Filling out these fields is the final step of configuring your [Ethos](#), [Anthology](#), or [Workday](#) connection.

### Ethos/Anthology

Setting	Notes
API Base URL	Enter the base URL provided by Ethos or Anthology.
API Key	Use the API key generated by Ethos or Anthology.

### Workday

Setting	Notes
Workday API Endpoint	<p>Enter your Workday endpoint information (base URL and tenant ID) into the provided fields.</p> <p>The Workday API Endpoint has a format similar to the following. Note that the base URL (ending in /service) and the tenant ID should be entered in different fields.</p> <div>https://&lt;workday hostname&gt;.workday.com/ccx/service/&lt;tenant_ID&gt;/</div>
API Username API Password	Enter credentials for your Workday integration service user.
Term Codes for Auto Initialization	Enter up to three term codes that you want automatically <a href="#">initialized</a> on a recurring basis (time interval is determined by CollegeNET) to keep Workday and 25Live course section data synchronized.

SIS Student Transaction Log Outbound Connector ID	<p>Enter the integration system ID for the <a href="#">Student Transaction Log Outbound Connector</a>. To find this in Workday:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Search for "View Integration System"</li> <li>2. Enter Integration System name</li> <li>3. Go to Actions &gt; Integration IDs &gt; View IDs</li> <li>4. Enter the value for "Integration_System_ID" in LYNX</li> </ol>
Import Section Registered Head Count	<p>Enabling this setting will allow LYNX to run a custom report in Workday to track registered head count. You must <a href="#">configure this report</a> first for the setting to have an effect.</p> <div>  <p><b>Tip: Instructor Contacts</b></p> <p>When defining section instructors in <a href="#">LYNX Settings - Organizations and Contacts</a>, there are special settings for Workday.</p> </div>
