Defining Discrete Dropdown Options for Event Custom Attributes

25Live allows you to add discrete options in the form of dropdown choices to event custom attributes you or your administrator(s) have defined. This functionality allows you to let event creators more accurately convey information with limited choices rather than a freeform text field.

Dropdown options for custom attributes show in the Event Details view and can be edited inline.





2. Use the Show Button to Reveal Options

Any custom attribute that is of the type to allow discrete options will have a **Show** button next to it in the **Discrete Options** column. Use the button to reveal the option actions.

Reminder: Custom Attributes Need to Be Mapped

To show custom attributes when users are creating events, they must be associated with either:

- An Event Type in System Settings
- Logic within the Event Form Rules
