## Issues when installing JReport Report Designer on a Windows 10 machine

After running the JReport Designer installer, you may note that no icon is placed on the desktop. Additionally, if you run **C:\JReport\Designer\bin\JReport.bat**, you receive an error like the following:

The folder "\$USER\_INSTALL\_DIR\$" is not REPORTHOME please set the correct REPORTHOME Press any key to continue...

## 1. Edit the Setenv Batch File

• Open the setenv.bat file-located in the C:\JReport\Designer\bin\ directory-in a text editor.

• Update the REPORTHOME line to reflect your JReport Designer installation directory and your JAVAHOME line to reflect your JDK installation directory.





• Save your changes.

## 2. Replace the Report Configuration Settings File

Try running JReport.bat once more and keep an eye out for the following error message.
 C:\JReport\Designer\bin\report.ini is corrupted. Make sure it's in correct format.

Press Enter key to continue.

- If you encounter this error, replace the report.ini file from the C:\JReport\Designer\bin\ folder with the zipped report.ini file that is attached here @.
  - Note that the file refers to the default installation path of C:\JReport\Designer. If your installation differs, you will need to update the report.ini file to reflect the correct path.
