

## Creating a Featured Events Custom Attribute

The next step in preparing your 25Live environment for the use of Featured Events requires you to complete some work in your 25Live System Settings. Here, you will need to:

- Create a **Featured Events** custom attribute and
- Connect this new custom attribute to your **Event Types** in the **Event Type Hierarchy**.

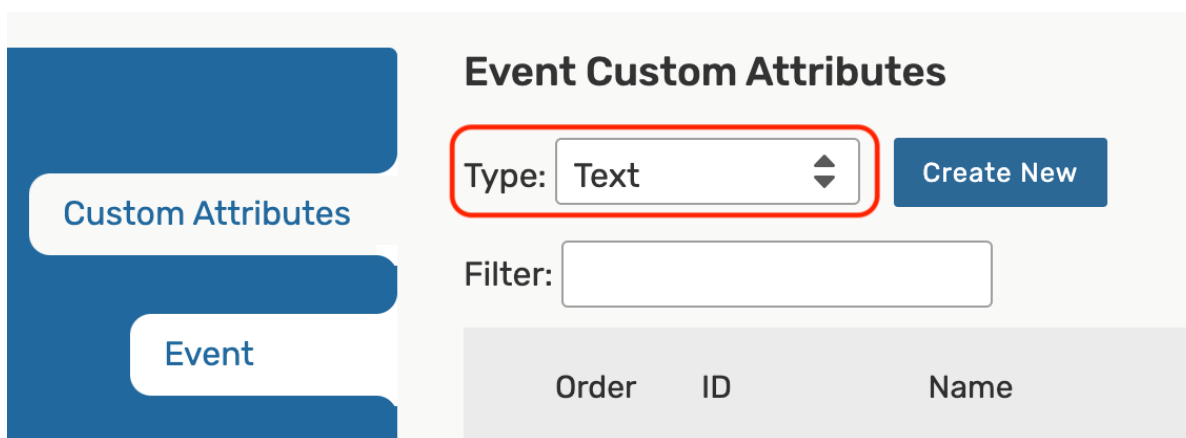
### Create the Featured Events Custom Attribute

#### 1. Open the Event Custom Attributes View

Use the 25Live **More** menu to navigate to **System Settings > Master Definitions > Custom Attributes > Event**.

#### 2. Edit the Type

Before using the button to create a new custom attribute, **Text** from the **Type** dropdown menu.

#### 3. Use the Create New Button

To add a new custom attribute, use the **Create New** button to add a new custom attribute. Your new attribute will appear at the top of the list.

#### 4. Rename the New Custom Attribute

The new attribute will appear with a default name that includes its ID number. Use the edit icon (  ) to rename the new custom attribute (eg. **Featured Events**).

### Add The Custom Attribute to the Event Type Hierarchy

#### 1. Navigate to Your Event Type in System Settings
