- Users can now set [event save scenarios](#) to apply when To Do tasks are created, completed, or ignored.
- Building and feature variables are now available for selection in table and list builders in Document Management.
- Administrators can now configure the "Include Requested" box on [availability grids](#) to be checked or unchecked by default using a new setting in **System Settings > General Settings > User Defaults** called "Availability Grid Include Requests".
- A new pricing option allows you to allocate line item adjustments when moving an occurrence to a new invoice.
- *Other Fixes and Improvements:*
 - The 25Live link no longer displays when the box labelled "Include link to 25Live" is left unchecked in the event **More Actions > Email Event**.
 - Event details emails no longer display "undefined" for segmented events.
 - Addressed issue that could cause an unwanted .01 cents to be reduced from a payment amount in event pricing.
 - Improvements made to URL/File custom attributes to prevent issues when switching between the URL and Image view while making selections.
 - Event save email scenarios no longer fail to run when a text based custom attribute is added that has an numerical custom value.
 - Various styling improvements have been made to configuration elements in the Occurrences scope in **System Settings > Document Management**.
 - Labelling improvements have been incorporated into the Preferences section of events that have multiple segments.
 - In smaller browser sizes, the Event Form link (which is usually located in the navigation bar) is now available in the More menu.
 - Corrected issue where clicking "Categories +" too quickly from the event search page could result in the "Filter By Tag" dropdown missing from the Categories pop-up modal.
 - Emails now allow for file attachments up to 25MB in size.
 - Fixed issue where adjusting an event's time after selecting a location in the event form could circumvent event quota checks.
 - Custom attributes that are created as "text" types, then later changed to include multiple value selection options, now behave as expected and display all discrete options.
 - The "Edit Task Notification" modal now prevents duplicate contact names from displaying under "Assigned to" for tasks in the same state.
 - In **System Settings > General Settings > User Activity > Pending Locations/Resources**, numerical object names no longer prevent filtering of the list.
 - Made improvements to the Categories section of the event form so that category names no longer overflows outside of their respective boxes.
 - Adding and removing a mix of locations before saving, some with a set location scheduler and some without, no longer results in the incorrect scheduler being saved to the event for institutions that have the

event form presentation setting "Use Selected Location's Associated Scheduler (when applicable)".

- Fixed issue in Document Management where users with View Only rights on a document would see 'undefined' display if the document had nothing entered into the Description field.
 - In the Document Management "Event Listing - Excel" scope, "Location Requests" and "Resource Requests" have been relabelled to "Location Preferences" and "Resource Preferences".
 - Users will no longer encounter an error indicating that multiple event form rules cannot have the same name in cases where a new [Action Rule](#)'s name matches an existing [Validation Rule](#)'s name and vice versa.
 - Locations that are not available due to configured exceptions no longer appear as available when using the "Find Available Locations" widget.
 - Fixed issue where event save scenarios would not always trigger if a user changed the event state and then quickly approved an assignment task immediately after.
 - Restored functionality of the "Location Formal Name" variable when using the List Builder option in an Event Save Email template.
 - For consistency with other custom attributes, multi-value text custom attributes are no longer displayed on event Details pages if there is no data associated with them.
 - Organization rule target elements no longer overflow their containers in smaller screen widths.
 - The "Copy" button on documents is now disabled when a user's security group has Not Visible permissions on the parent shell report (i.e. Event Contract, Organization Shell, etc) and the user does not have Override Report Security permission.
 - Improvements made to SeriesQL search functionality.
 - New improvements prevent rules and conflict checking from running in cases where a user quickly closes an event form after selecting objects that have associated rules.
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
